I think you should try it again once before giving up.

Don' try to delete anything yourself. Either let the script do its deletion job or not.

re Steps 1 2 3 4 5

- 1) I think the previously running batch file must still have been there. I did not see a blank Command
- 2) I had an admin prompt.
- 3) Don't remember seeing the original command window closing but I was pretty confused so could have missed it even if it happened.
- 4) This was definitely there saying success
- 5) Instruction to restart the computer, press any key. was definitely there.

I pressed any key twice but nothing happened, so I restarted in the usual way from the Start /Power Buttons. I lost the thread and had to sign in again. So am not certain it has completed - is there any way we can tell?

I think some of the problem is that I do not always give the computer chance to do anything before I carry on.
